ANNUAL VEGETABLE

Peppers

Sweet Pepper varieties have been selected for their mild flavor and thick walls. Hot Pepper varieties are small-fruited and less highly bred than bell types, but are much more vigorous growers.

CULTURE: These are heat loving plants. Provide deep watering. Allowing soil to dry out in-between watering. A floating row cover will extend the season and aid in better fruit production.

PLANTING: Best if transplanted out when the soil has warmed to at least 60°F. Set plants 12-18" apart in rows 24-30" apart. Water carefully and evenly. Do not get the leaves wet.

FERTILIZING: High phosphorous soil amendments such as bone meal will help plants get off to a fast start. Organic fertilizer dug into soil around each plant will help too. Be careful of the shallow root systems.

HARVESTING: Fruit set usually around August - September.
