As you will see, our application requires a personal statement that should include specific information about your educational plans. Among other things, you should indicate how you plan to finance your education and provide an estimate of the tuition, housing and related costs that you expect to incur with your schooling. We realize that some of these costs may only be estimates, but it gives us an idea of your projected financial need and may also assist you in preparing a financial plan. The web site includes a list of the scholarships offered, including any requirements or criteria. Check out the list, so you can be sure to address any specific criteria in your application. Check the site often, as new scholarships may be added as they are finalized.

Please note, we require that you are planning to attend an accredited school. Most schools have accreditation information on their web page. The Department of Education also maintains a database of accredited schools at <a href="https://www.ed.gov/accreditation">https://www.ed.gov/accreditation</a>. Feel free to contact me or your school counselor if you have questions.

Please note that we do not award scholarships for students who have attained a 4-year degree, and who are pursuing a graduate degree.
